LESSON PLAN

TOPIC AREA: A green initiative

DATE:

SKILLS:

- **to acknowledge the importance of ecotourism**
- **to develop a sense of tolerance and acceptance**
- **to organize and perform presentations and debate**
- **to learn about eco-friendly activities**
- **to recognize and use vocabular belonging to the topic**

LANGUAGE FUNCTIONS:

- expressing opinions
- discussing aims / goals
- drawing conclusions
- discussing the effects, advantages / disadvantages of something
- interpreting data (drawings, pictures, statements ..)

LEARNING AIMS: the students are expected to:

- assess their knowledge of the topic
- **develop critical thinking**
- **interact in pairs and with the class**
- **present their research to the class and explain it**
- **learn about tourism that respects nature**
- **learn about animals and plants of protected areas**

ASSESSMENT:

- direct observation
- behaviour, level of concentration and participation

PROCEDURE:

1st step:

The teacher makes a brainstorming with the students. Several pictures of São Jacintos's dunes are shown to the students. Students comment on the pictures. Their comments are written on the board.

2nd step: The teacher asks the students to join in pairs and collect data /research on São Jacinto's dunes.

3rd step: The data/research is going to be presented on a geography/history/science class, where several activities with fauna and flora, geography and history are going to be carried out.

4th step: Students are going to camp at São Jacinto's dunes. They are going to watch in loco the animals, plants, nature they studied before.
