ACTIVATING TEACHING METHODS TO MAKE TEACHING GREEN ENTREPRENEURSHIP MORE EFFECTIVE

METHOD 1 _ PROJECT WORK



- **collaborative work + community involvement**
- **students prepare eco surveys, based on research and background check, they interview local community representatives to assess their ecological awareness, this is to promote active involvement in community life for the benefit of natural environment protection**

METHOD 2 _ NEWEST TECHNOLOGIES in green activity



- **use of newest technologies/ICT tools&systems to promote responsible ecological citizenship**
- **students make use of available tools, technologies to promote green ideas, they bring out ECO bulletins, brochures, leaflets (electronic versions), these are published through available channels to promote the idea of natural heritage protection**

METHOD 3 _ MULTISENSORY TEACHING in green education



- **multisensory teaching techniques used to stimulate learning at different levels and meeting varied educational needs**
- **discover your student's LEARNING STYLE**

LEARNING STYLES – how to approach them? Why?



I. To stimulate visual reasoning and learning

- ▶ text and/or pictures on paper, posters, models, projection screens, computers or flash cards, use of colour, graphics, images, etc.

II. Auditory techniques

- ▶ e- Books, peer assisted reading, computerized text readers, music, etc.

III. Tactile teaching methods

Multisensory techniques that involve using the sense of touch.

- ▶ modelling materials such as clay and sculpting materials, textured objects, finger paints and puzzles to improve fine motor skills, etc.

IV. Kinaesthetic methods

- ▶ Multisensory methods using body movements, such as games, activities involving concepts, rhythmic recall and academic competition such as quizzes, flash card races and other learning games.

- ▶ **All the above mixed together or adjusted to individual student's needs will help them learn new ecological contexts in a more effective way.**
